

Referral Documents List

The autism program provides a setting that emphasizes the development of communication, self help, social, motor, and cognitive skills. The program revolves around a highly structured school setting based on the unique learning characteristics of each individual.

The following information is needed for ALL referrals:

- Summary of previous classroom strategies tried and level of success
- Current Individual Education Plan (IEP) including the behavior intervention plan
- Most recent eligibility report
- School psychological evaluation
- Social Development Study
- Outside agency involvement (YSB, North Central, etc.)
- Achievement testing reports (Including Universal Screening and Progress Monitoring/Intervention Data)
- Report cards/checklist data
- Vision/hearing screening information
- Discipline history/records
- Discharge summary from any and all hospitalizations
- Discharge summary from previous agencies/providers
- List of medication and dosages

If placement occurs at autism program the following additional information will be needed:

- Copy of birth certificate
- Copy of Illinois Public Aid card
- Medical history/records
- Current immunization record
- Dental record
- Reduces/free lunch form
- Social security card/number
- Lead screening test
