The Circuit Breaker School provides a setting whereby the dual goals of teaching appropriate social/emotional behavior and increasing academic performance can be satisfied. The program revolves around a highly structured school setting based upon a comprehensive behavior management system.

The following information is needed for ALL referrals:

- Current Individual Education Plan (IEP) including the behavior intervention plan and transition plan
- Most recent eligibility report
- School psychological evaluation
- Social Development Study
- Outside agency involvement (YSB, North Central, etc.)
- Achievement testing reports (Including Universal Screening and Progress Monitoring Data)
- Report cards/ High School transcripts
- Vision/hearing screening information
- Discipline history/records
- Any court orders currently in effect
- Discharge summary from any and all hospitalizations
- Discharge summary from previous agencies/providers
- List of medications and dosages

If placement occurs at Circuit Breaker School the following additional information will be needed:

- Copy of birth certificate
- Copy of Illinois Public Aid card
- Medical history/records
- Immunization record
- Dental record
- Reduced/free lunch form
- Social Security card/number
